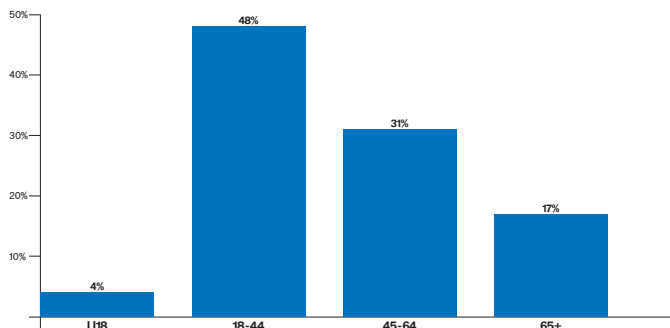

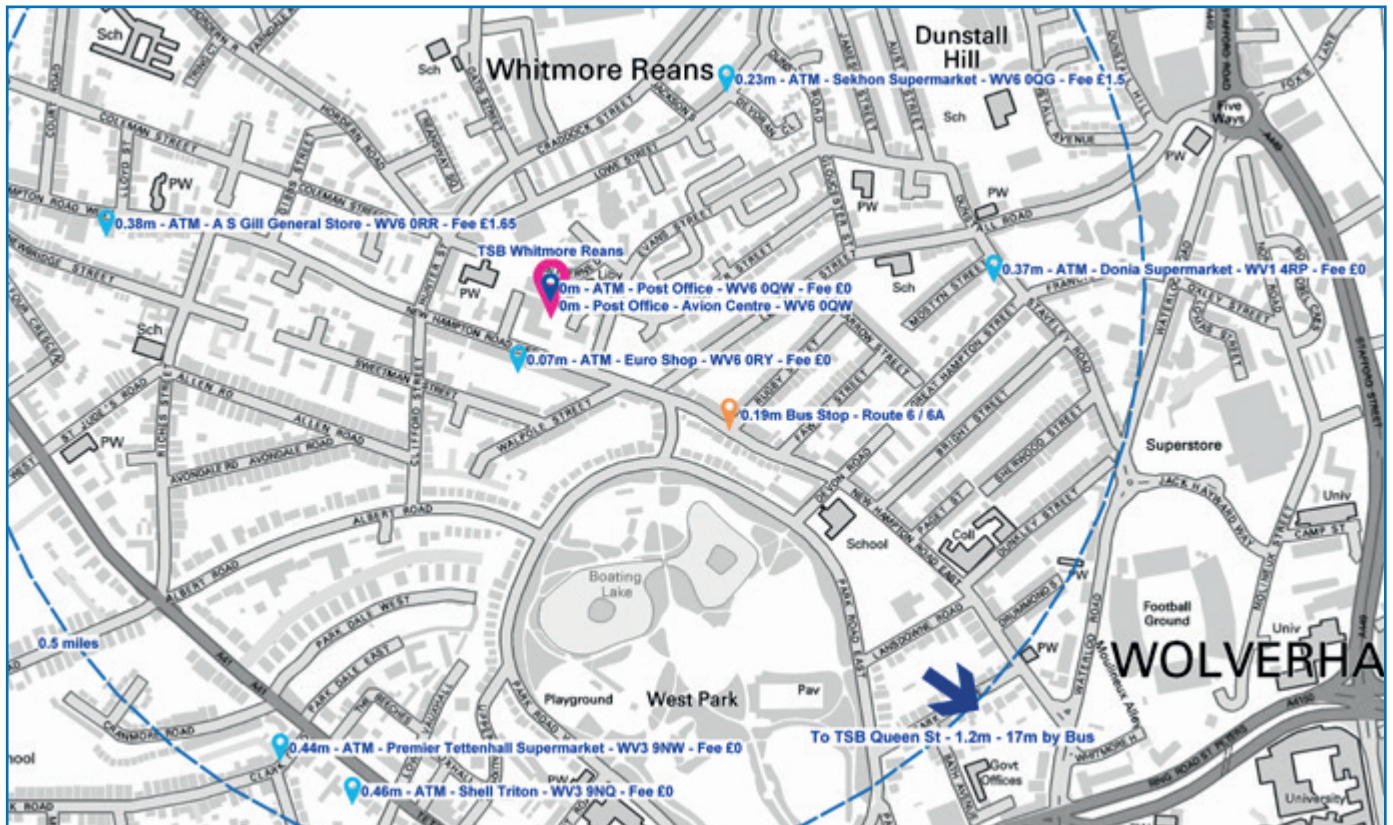

# Whitmore Reans Branch Closure Review



## Community Engagement

TSB has been engaging with local stakeholders about the impact of the closure of the Whitmore Reans branch on the local community.

### What we've done to help customers with the changes:

- We have written to all of our Whitmore Reans customers to provide them with information on the location of their nearest TSB branch on Queen Street and to let them know about alternative ways to bank with TSB.
- We are displaying important information on posters in the Whitmore Reans branch to let customers know about the banking options that are available to them.
- Our Partners in our Whitmore Reans branch are discussing customers' questions and concerns, providing advice on alternative arrangements, including parking near our Queen Street branch and the location of nearby ATMs. They are taking extra care to help our most vulnerable customers with the transition.
- Partners are also helping customers use and register for online, mobile and telephone banking.
- Our Whitmore Reans customers will shortly be able to benefit from the newly refitted branch on Queen Street, which will provide more face-to-face meeting spaces, better banking technology and more TSB Partners on hand to help.
- TSB also has an arrangement with the Post Office. Personal customers are able to use the local branch, located in the Avion Centre, to check their balance, make cash withdrawals and cash and cheque deposits.
- We will not be making any redundancies as a result of this decision.
