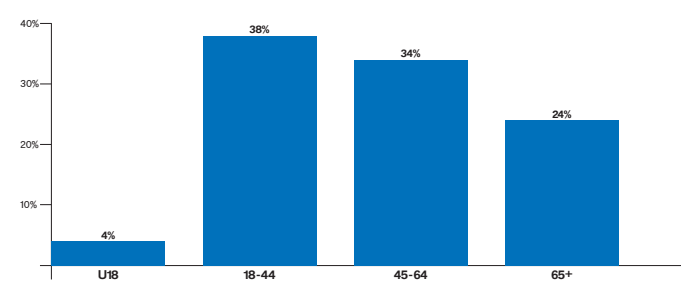

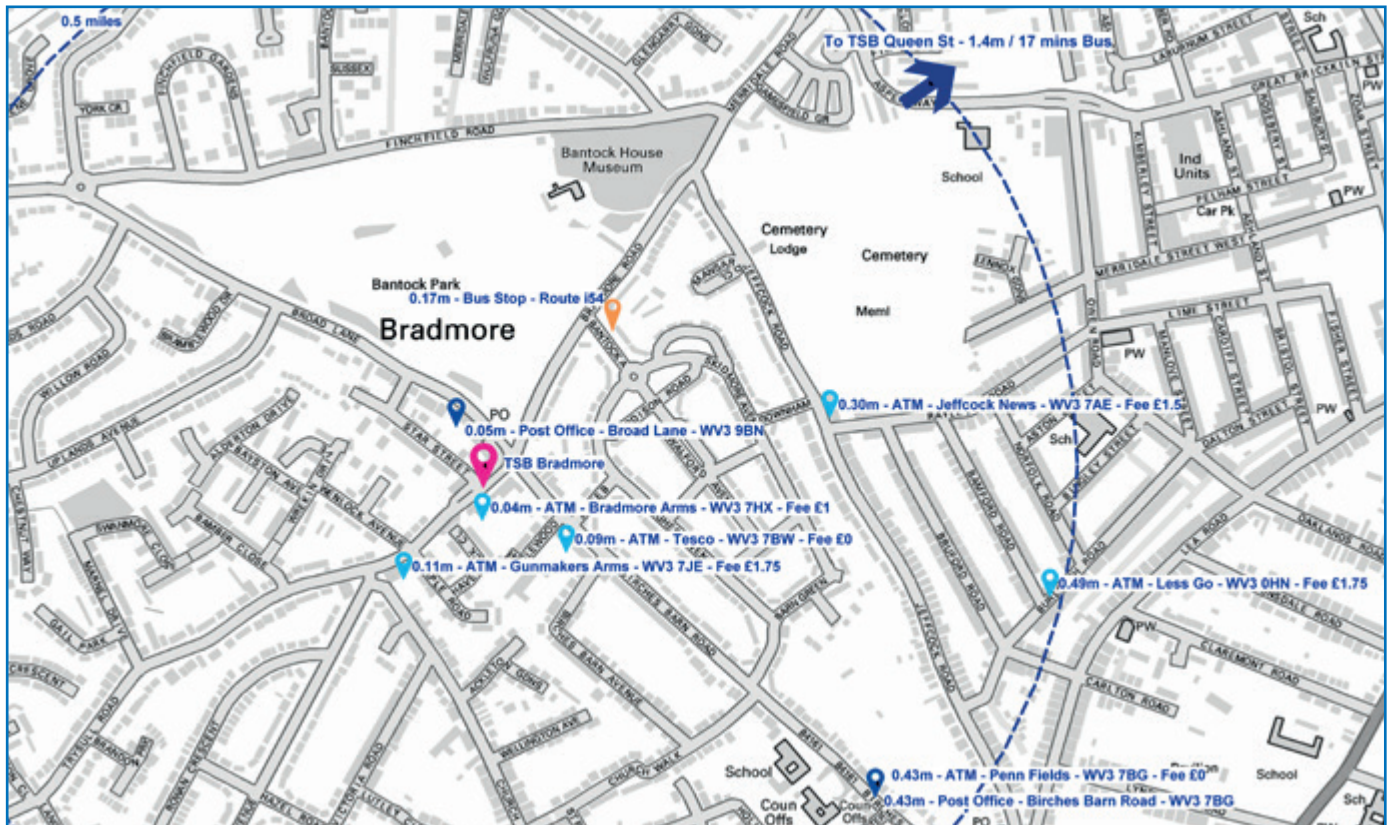

Community Engagement

TSB has been engaging with local stakeholders about the impact of the closure of the Bradmore branch on the local community.

Who we spoke to:

- The local Member of Parliament, Rob Marris MP
- Representatives of Merry Hill Council Ward
- Black Country Chamber of Commerce
- Local Federation of Small Businesses
- Local Citizens Advice Bureau

What we heard:

- TSB was questioned about the distance some customers and small businesses may have to travel to an alternative branch.
- TSB was asked what the closure will mean for TSB Partners who work at the Bradmore branch.

What we've done to help customers with the changes:

- We have written to all of our Bradmore customers to provide them with information on the location of their nearest TSB branch on Queen Street and to let them know about alternative ways to bank with TSB.
- We are displaying important information on posters in the Bradmore branch to let customers know about the banking options that are available to them.
- Our Partners in our Bradmore branch are discussing customers' questions and concerns, providing advice on alternative arrangements and details on nearby ATMs. They are taking extra care to help our most vulnerable customers with the transition.
- Partners are also helping customers use and register for telephone, online and mobile banking.
- Our Bradmore customers will shortly be able to benefit from the newly refitted branch on Queen Street, which will provide more face-to-face meeting spaces, better banking technology and more TSB Partners on hand to help.
- TSB also has an arrangement with the Post Office. Personal customers are able to use their local branch located on Broad Lane, to check their balance, make cash withdrawals and make cash and cheque deposits.
